Police searching for missing Oxgangs man who has travelled to Aberdeen

Edinburgh Police are appealing for the help of the public to trace a 78-year-old man reported missing from Oxgangs who has travelled to Aberdeen.

Thomas Phillips left his home in Oxgangs Park and took a bus to Aberdeen where he was seen at the bus station in Guild Street around 1.30pm on Tuesday, 24 May. He may have gone towards the railway station looking for a taxi.

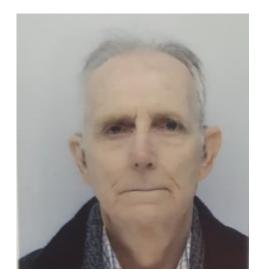
He is described as around 5ft 2ins, of slim build, with grey, balding hair. He usually wears glasses and has a swallow and thistle tattoos on both arms. It is not known what he is wearing but could be a blue jacket and black jeans.

Inspector Keith Scott said: "We are becoming increasingly concerned about Thomas. He has dementia and could possibly become disorientated. He also walks with a hunch and uses a walking stick and I would urge anyone who may have seen him or knows where he is to get in touch.

"We know he took a bus to Aberdeen so I am urging anyone who may have seen him at the bus station to get in touch, particularly taxi drivers.
