If an event is cancelled then the cost of the tickets will be reimbursed and cash turnstiles will continue to operate but anyone choosing that option will pay £5 for juniors (12-15 years) at Championship matches, £6 for double-headers, and £1 for under-11s.

Cash and online tickets are the only options. Berwick cannot accept card payments at the turnstiles and club co-owner Jamie Courtney said: "Booking online offers a big potential saving for the many family groups who might be thinking of watching their speedway at Berwick over the next couple of weeks.
