XCOM: Enemy Unknown

XCOM is another tactical shooting series that moves away from fantasy into futuristic sci-fi. You are required to lead specialized intelligence groups such as XCOM and other alien forces infiltrating and investigating alien threats to the earth. In turn-based ground combat the player directs the troops in combat, analyses information, and manages the organization. It costs 19 dollars.


