He said: "The dispute between the trade unions and other train operators does not involve any ScotRail staff, which means we'll be able to run our services as normal during the latest industrial action.

"A small number of ScotRail services to and from Carlisle will see some disruption, so customers travelling on this route should check their train times before leaving for the station.

"We'd also encourage anyone travelling to plan their journey in advance, as we're expecting our trains to be busier than normal due to customers of other operators travelling with ScotRail."
