As an EU citizen, you may remain in Bulgaria for three months without registering. This time is usually plenty for business visits and firm formation. When staying longer than three months, you must register with local authorities. EU citizens in Bulgaria for more than three months require a long-term permit.

Long-term EU residents may apply for permanent residence and citizenship in Bulgaria. EU citizens may seek for permanent residence after five years of lawful presence. Naturalization after 10 years of legal residence or sooner under specific investment or extraordinary situations grants Bulgarian

citizenship.
