
A Dedicated Software Development Team: What Is It?

Ukraine

Ukraine, a country in Eastern Europe, offers enormous benefits to nascent IT firms and businesses. First of all, the education and literacy levels of Ukrainians are excellent. Based on statistical data, over 130,000 developers graduate from educational institutions each year, making them qualified to work on innovative and stimulating projects.

Hiring developers, designers, and programmers from Ukraine is the greatest choice if you want to save money. This place has much lower pay rates than other European nations.

China

When it comes to offshore project relocation, China is among the most sought-after locations. Moreover, this is the preferred nation for big data and Python, Shell, and other programming language projects. Millions of IT graduates graduate each year from this nation, which is one of the top outsourcing destinations in the IT sector. It is home to several software development organizations that are expanding quickly. China now offers software development services of far higher quality than it did a few years ago.

Mexico

But be aware that good customer service and simple communication are not free; the typical hourly wage for a middle-level software engineer in North America is around \$132.

With a strong emphasis on technology, Canada has a strong educational system, with 18.6% of graduates holding STEM degrees. According to the well-known HackerRank website, programmers in Canada are rated 21st in terms of real skill levels.
