Will it ever be anything other than that for some of us? It is of course now Lloyds Banking Group's main office.

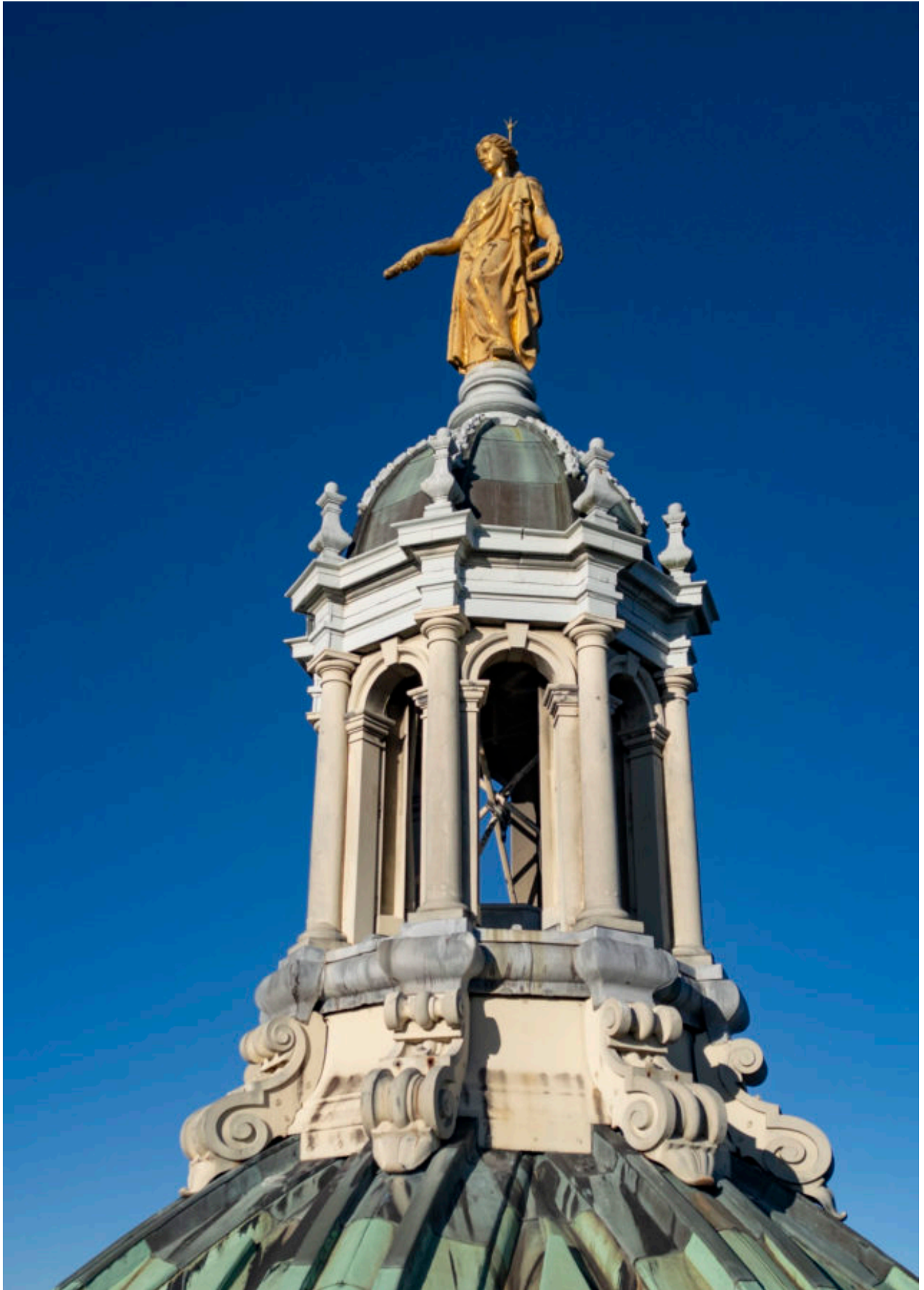
