Missing woman — fresh appeal for information

Edinburgh police are renewing their appeal to the public and seeking help in trying to locate 35-year-old, Khasha Smith, missing from the Calder area of Edinburgh.

On Friday, 5 January, 2024 a member of Khasha's family contacted police to report her missing and inform them that she had not been in contact since 1 and 4 November, 2023.

Khasha is around 5ft tall, and is of slim build. She has blue eyes and long, blonde hair. She also has tattoos, one which is visible on her right wrist and says 'Forever'.

Extensive enquiries are under way to trace Khasha but there have been no confirmed sightings or contact since early November and her family is concerned.

Officers are checking a potential sighting in Slateford between 21 and 24 of November, 2023.

Officers are reviewing any relevant CCTV footage in the hope that it will provide additional information on where Khasha has gone.

Inspector Keith Forrester said: "We are extremely concerned for Khasha. She normally maintains contact with her family and it is unusual for her to not be in touch for this length of time. I am appealing to anyone who may have seen Khasha or who may have any information which could assist in us locating her to get in touch. Please don't think what you know is

irrelevant, let us decide its significance, your information could be vital in helping us trace Khasha."
