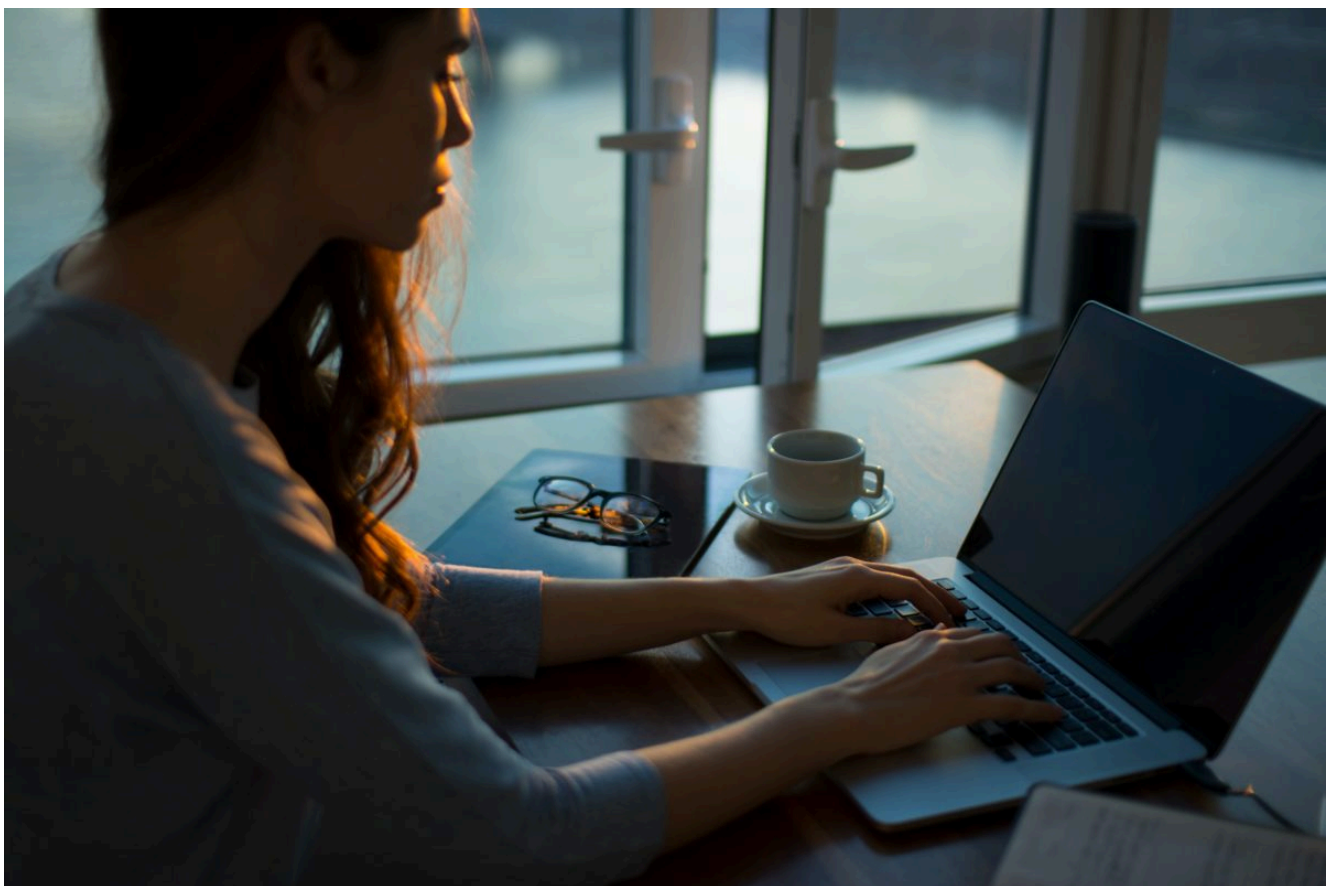


# Tips to Write Your Narrative Essay

## What is a Narrative Essay

In this type of essay, you are the narrator of the story and should write in the first person.

## How to Write a Narrative Essay

- Choose a topic: it is great if your teacher has given you a prompt to discuss. It will help you to come up with a topic that is relevant to the prompt. However, the situation becomes more difficult. If the teacher only told you to write a narrative essay without any hints. It is better to choose a topic that is relevant to your interests. Writing the essay will become easier if you know what you're writing about and want to develop the topic yourself.
- Create an outline: the big projects require the creation of an outline before working on them. After you have chosen a topic, you should divide the overall story into parts and decide what you will put in the introduction, what will go in the body paragraphs, and in the conclusion. Think about the sequence of events and how you will locate them throughout the story.
- Introduce the story: before proceeding to writing the main plot of your narrative essay you should introduce the background information. Tell what the story will be about: introduce the settings, the characters, and the events. This way you will explain the context of the story to the readers.

- Be creative: the most important thing about writing a narrative essay is to be creative. You need to introduce unique ideas to the readers and tell your story in an engaging way. If you seem to discuss something about your life you should create a cheerful tone or write it in a mysterious way. You can also use different quotations from your relatives and friends in the essay to make it more personalized.

That is how you can begin writing your narrative essay and build its context.

### Narrative Essay Ideas

You can choose any topic for the narrative essay. If you lack ideas we will provide you with a few topics for you:

1. Memorable event: you can recollect some memorable event from your childhood that you memorize frequently or which makes you happy. For example, hiking with your family or an exciting birthday party.

For example, some situations may have made you more open to communication or more confident.

4. Lesson learned: you can also describe the failure that has taught you valuable lessons. For example, you can describe the lesson you have learned after failing a competition or an exam. Tell how this situation has made you stronger and what new lessons you have understood.

If you have liked some of the ideas you can tailor them according to your experience or prompt. However, if you don't find anything that fits your prompt or requirement you can spend some time thinking about different topics.
