ATP rankings of Australian tennis players

The highest-ranked Australian tennis player is Alex de Minaur, who is at no. 11 in the list of ATP's top players after the Australian Open 2024. ATP (Association of Tennis

Professionals) revealed the list of the top 100 tennis players of the world and nine Australian players currently sit in this list. Here is a list of the top Aussie tennis players after the Australian Open:

How do tennis rankings work?

World Tennis rankings are computed by the ATP, who award position and points based on the performance of the players at particular tennis tournaments. The better a player performs in a sanctioned tournament, the more points will be granted to them.
