You can recognize a sponsored review by the following criteria:

- Overly positive tone;
- Lack of critical evaluation or personal experience;
- Advertisement in the review's body;
- Lack of consistency.

For example, the main page of EduReviewer highlights EduBirdie as the best writing service. The rest of the list is less noticeable. The number of reviewed categories does not contribute to objectivity, either.

The same is true for the "IHateWritingEssays" review platform. It points out the writing service "Pendrago" by a significant score gap. Advertising a product by contrasting its quality or price with similar objects is a common promotion technique. These services do not necessarily lack the quality. Yet, the review sites that practice such an approach to reviewing can hardly pass as credible sources.

NoCramming can serve as an opposite example. The platform provides relevant information and does not point out a specific essay writing service above the rest. Even the highest-grades services receive their fair share of criticism.
