Scotland lose heavily to "outstanding" England

The Scotland women's rugby team were resoundingly beaten on Saturday by England at Edinburgh's Hive Stadium.

The last two matches have ended with a narrow win over Wales and a defeat against France more recently.

But the match against England was an embarrassing result with the visitors scoring 46 points against a home team who failed to put any points on the board. Even a record sell out crowd of 7,774 could not rouse the women.

England scored the points from eight tries by Cokayne, Dow, Kildunne, Kabeya, Breach and Packer. Cokayne was sent off for a second yellow card, but that and the very windy conditions did not prevent the English side from achieving their third win from three matches.
