

Annual Caravan Show celebrating big anniversary year at Pettycur Bay

The annual Caravan Show Weekend at Pettycur Bay will also be an advance celebration of the Wallace family buying the park four decades ago.

The family will be starting the celebrations ahead of the actual anniversary in July when the annual Caravan Show Weekend takes place from Friday 24 May to Sunday 26 May 2024.

The park has grown considerably over the years, with a community feeling at its heart, and the event will showcase the industry leading luxury holiday homes available for ownership.
