## Brown tells Tigers: 'we need to click back into gear'

Glasgow team manager, Cami Brown, demanded a new energy from his side against Redcar Bears as the Allied Vehicles Tigers face a Cab Direct Championship clash at Ashfield Stadium on Friday (7.30pm).
