Boyle featured in his first major tournament earlier this year with the Socceroos and has a chance to add to 28 international caps and eight goals next month.

Defender Rocky Bushiri has been called up for Dr Congo's upcoming FIFA World Cup Qualifiers against Senegal and Togo.

Dr Congo currently sit third in qualification group B after two games and travel to Senegal on Thursday 6 June, before hosting Togo on Sunday 9 June.

Jojo Wollacott also features on the international stage – representing Ghana in their FIFA World Cup qualifiers.

Wollacott has made 12 international senior caps, most recently

featuring in March 2024. Ghana take on Mali on Thursday 6 and Central Africa on Monday 10 June.

Midfielder Nathan Moriah Welsh has been called up to represent Guyana for their North/Central America World Cup qualifiers.
