The Scottish Beacon is holding its very first public event in Edinburgh during Indie News Week which will take place between 3 and 9 June 2024.

The week long events are being promoted by the [Public Interest News Foundation](#) (PINF) which seeks to support independent news in the UK.

The Edinburgh Reporter is a founder member of The Scottish Beacon, which is a collaborative journalism project.

Everyone is invited to the Edinburgh event which will feature talks and discussions about local news, and will take place on 7 June at Grassmarket Community Project.
