

Green candidate to take part in Portobello's Sea Rising Festival

The Scottish Green Party candidate for the general election will take to the stage at a festival on the Portobello promenade on Saturday 22 June.

The Sea Rising Festival is organised by Porty Community Energy. It will include free music, a ceilidh, a maker's markets, stalls, free bike trials and arts and crafts workshops.

Amanda Grimm, the Scottish Greens candidate for Edinburgh East and Musselburgh, will speak briefly about her campaign, before introducing Joanie and the Water, a singer-songwriter and a band of local musicians from the Portobello Tap weekly trad and folk session.
