1- Tabuk

Located northwest of Saudi Arabia, Tabuk lies close to the Jordanian border. It is the capital of the Tabuk region and is set at 760 m above sea level. The city boasts numerous natural and cultural sites. The ancient Tabuk forest, dating back to 3500 BCE is the place of the battle of Tabuk, mentioned in Surah Tawbah of the Holy Quran.

Hijaz railway station, built in the Ottoman era, is another famous place in the city. This historical train depot once linked Damascus to Medina. Today, it serves as a museum, housing artifacts and historic models. The city is also famous for beautiful Wadi Al Disah, a part of the Prince Mohammad bin Salman Natural Reserve.

Jebel Al-Lawz or the Mountain of Almonds, is another major highlight of Tabuk. During winter, the mountain's peak is covered with snow. Many global tourists enjoy hiking on the mount's challenging treks. The prime location and features of Jebel Al-Lawz resemble Mount Sinai, where Prophet Moses (A.S) had a notable meeting with Allah.

Mosses Well, present in the old city of Madyan attracts countless global tourists. Madyan is an archeological site in Tabuk, where you can find 4000-year-old houses made from rocks.

2- Abha

Perched in the southwestern region of the Saudi state, Abha is the capital of the Asir province. It is 2270 m above sea level and often called "Bride of the Mountains". The city is known for lush greenery, misty mountains, and refreshing weather, especially during winter. Random rainfalls during December and January add to the city's charm, making it a perfect winter retreat for all.

The routes to Rijal Almaa and Al Habala Hanging Village are one of the top lures of Abha. Here, tourists can see the beautiful Sarawat Mountains with a thrilling cable car ride. Asir National Park, a haven for nature lovers, is also located in the city. Shada Palace and the old village of Rijal Almaa show the region's rich history.

The city is also adorned with vibrant artwork and jacaranda trees. Abha is one of the famous Saudi spots for camping, paragliding, and snorkeling.
