## City firm invests in new vehicles

## St Andrews Timber & Building Supplies has upgraded its landscaping division by investing in two new vehicles.

The fleet will now include a Volvo FE 320 Dropside based at its Stenhouse branch, and a Mercedes Actros 2533 will work from the firm's west coast headquarters in Paisley.

The 14-tonne trucks can both carry 12 tonnes and are each fitted with a Fassi F155 crane.

The six-figure investment significantly improves what the landscape side of the business can offer at both branches as the company looks to continue to develop that side of the business.
