

How to Choose a Fast Withdrawal Casino in the UK

What are Fast Withdrawal Casinos?

Fast withdrawal casinos are online casinos that process withdrawals quicker than regular online casinos do. They are sometimes referred to as instant withdrawal casinos, but this is a bit of an exaggeration. Instead, withdrawals typically take one business day or less to be processed. Since some regular online casinos can take an average of three to five business days to complete a withdrawal, this is a significant improvement.

The reason that withdrawals take longer to process than deposits is that online casinos must follow a [Know Your Customer \(KYC\) protocol](#) before releasing any funds. KYC protocols protect the casino and customers from fraud. The KYC protocol verifies the player's identity, their address and sometimes the source of their funds. A thorough KYC protocol is a strong protection for players, but it can also add several days to the average withdrawal time.

Fast withdrawal casinos do not bypass KYC; that would be a bad idea. Instead, they verify their players' identities when they create their accounts and before they make their first withdrawal. This information is stored so that future withdrawals can be processed quickly since the KYC protocol has already been taken care of.

The other reason that fast withdrawal casinos can process withdrawals quickly is that they limit the available withdrawal methods to those that have high levels of security. Methods like debit cards, PayPal and bank transfers already have protections in place for their users, so the casino can trust that any identity verification required on that end has

already been taken care of.

Below, we will provide a brief description of the previously mentioned list of online casinos with fast withdrawals for UK players.

Duelz
