Your Flower Beds

So, there must be shade on them during the hours of scorching heat for their survival.

The second important factor is soil condition. Get the soil tested before planting your seeds, so you know about the additional nutrient requirements and pH balance chemicals you need to make the soil favourable for plant growth. Thirdly, make sure that your garden hose is near the flower beds, so you can water them at the right time. Water-wise technologies are also available that water your plants at the scheduled times.

Once you have chosen the areas for crafting the flower beds, it is time to design the layout. Traditional long beds along the walkways are a good option but you can consider more layouts like rectangular or circular beds in various locations at your home for a personalised touch. Moreover, ensure an appropriate drainage system as over-retention of water can be damaging to your flowers. Incorporate an optimum layout for the flower beds, so it does not get damaged due to human traffic.

Step-by-Step Guide for Crafting Beautiful Flower Beds

When you are done with all the above considerations, here is a step-by-step guideline for creating elegant flower beds on your home lawn.

1. Eliminating Botanicals from Selected Areas

The first step is to remove all the botanicals from the area you have selected for your flower beds. Mostly, home lawns are covered with grass and you need to eliminate it for a trouble-free growth of your flowers. The traditional method of grass removal by budding it off using a shovel on soaked soil is now replaced by efficient machines that root out all the turf. Solarization is also a more effective method for killing grass by trapping sunlight but it takes a few weeks. You can choose your favourable option according to your resources.

2. Replenish the Soil

The next step is to prepare the soil for plantation. You must have tested the soil before getting started. Continue with the material suggested by the professionals to enhance the quality of your soil. You can add organic matter, compost, manure etc as suggested after the soil test. Moreover, pH adjustment is another important task. So, add lime or sulphur as needed to your soil. You can also lay down the weed barrier fabric to suppress the weed growth and ensure the safety of your plants.

3. Plant your Flowers

Now move to the most awaited part, planting the little flowering plants that you have got from the nursery. Dig a hole in the soil with a length equal to the pot they came in. Take out the plants from the pot and gently place them in the soil. Cover the hole with soil and water the entire flower bed. Consider the size of fully grown plants while planting, so they will not overlap after growing to a mature state.

Pro-Tip 1: Before final planting, arrange the young plants on the bedding area to make sure that your chosen layout will look good after final planting.

Pro-Tip 2: Add mulch to your plant as insulating material for increased water retention and suppressing the growth of weeds. Wood clipping, leaves, compost, etc will do a great job for an eco-friendly garden.
