He said “It’s brilliant to get a ticket. I really didn’t think would ever get a chance to see them.

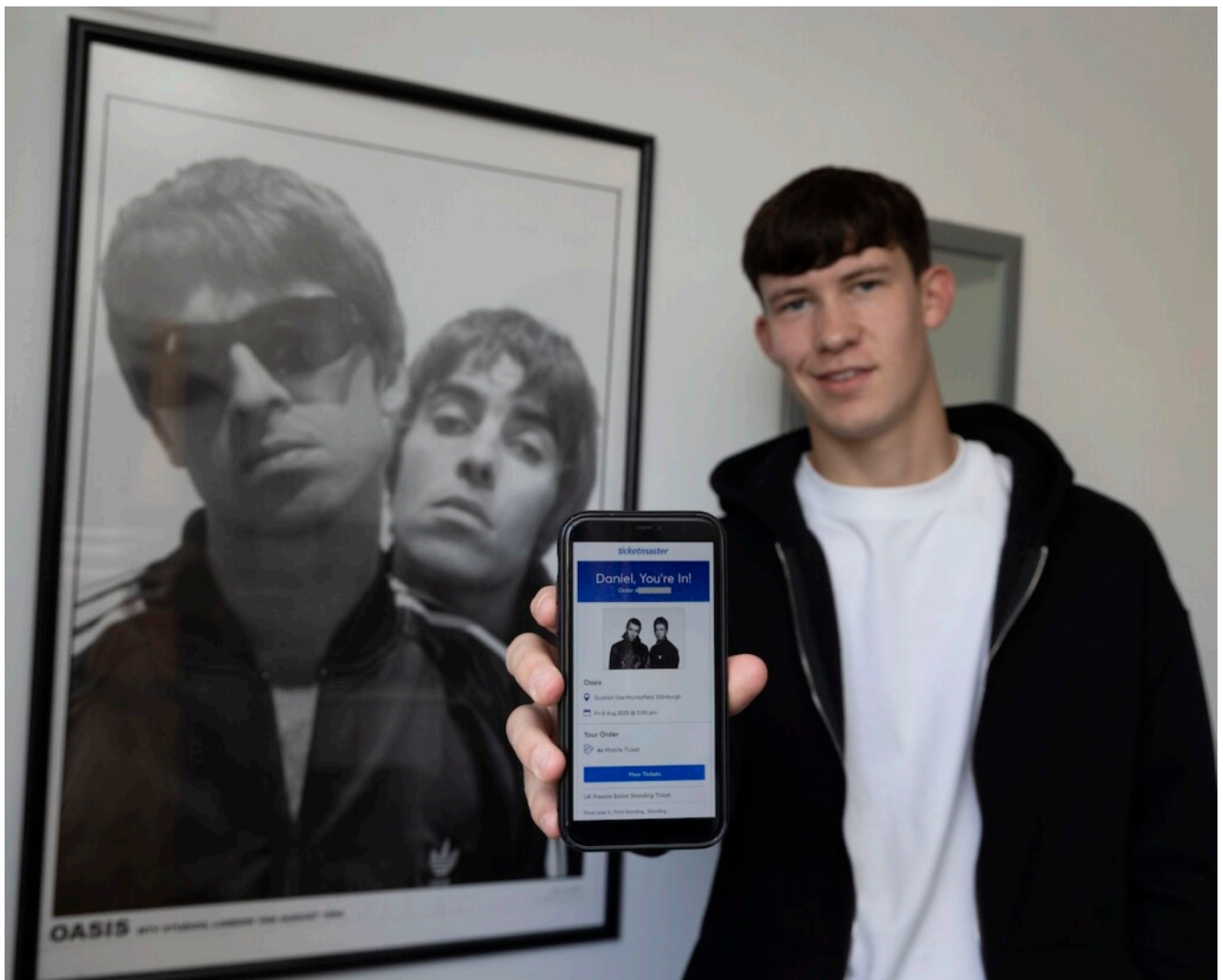
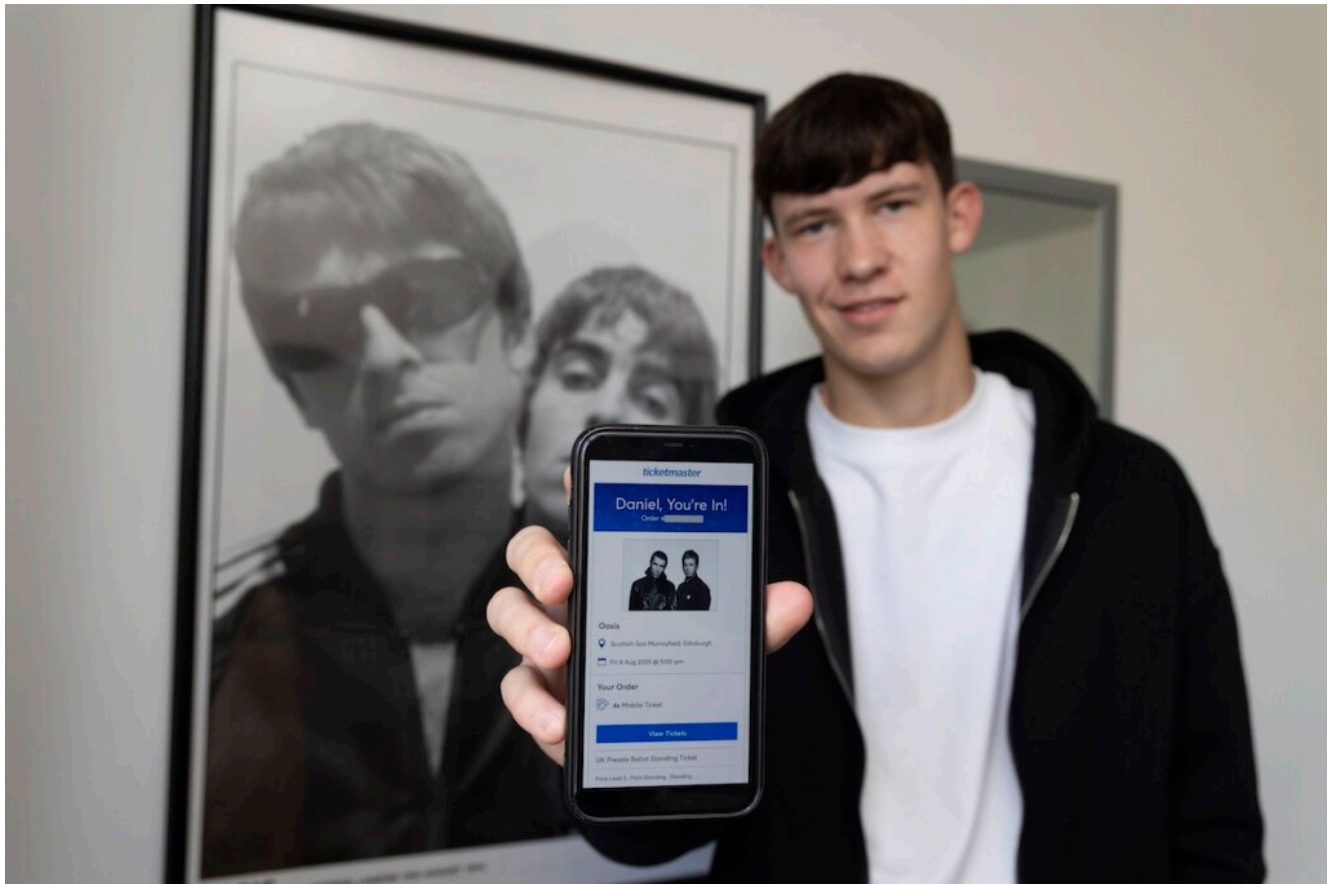
“Even better that the stadium is just a half an hour walk from my house.”
