Extensive cannabis cultivation discovered in West Calder

Drugs with an estimated street value of over £800,000 have been recovered at an address in West Lothian.

Around 8.50am on Tuesday, 10 September, officers searched a property on Young Street in West Calder.

An extensive cannabis cultivation was discovered inside.

Enquiries remain ongoing to trace those responsible.

Detective Constable Craig Drummond said: "This is a significant recovery and is an example of our efforts to disrupt the trade in illegal drugs in Scotland.

"It also underlines our commitment to the Serious Organised Crime Taskforce and the country's Serious Organised Crime Strategy.
