Hibs youngster Kanayo Megwa joins Partick Thistle on season long loan

Hibs youngster Kanayo Megwa has joined William Hill Championship side Partick Thistle on loan for the duration of the 2024/25 campaign.

The 20-year-old defender joined the Hibs Academy in 2021, progressing through the age grades before making his senior First Team debut in August 2023.

The promising defender already has over 50 senior appearances to his name, the majority of which came out on loan last season where he impressed at Airdrieonians.
