The Bothies, deliberately sited as far from tie in points to existing infrastructure, such as phone, water and electric,

provide an extremely comfortable, lower carbon footprint experience for guests. They can relax and explore the stunning National Park, whilst knowing that they're doing their bit to supporting sustainable tourism.
