

Motorcyclist 37 seriously hurt following crash in South Queensferry

Police are appealing for information following a serious crash in South Queensferry.

The collision happened on Kirkliston Road around 7.35pm on Wednesday, 18 September, and involved a black Audi A4 and a silver Yamaha motorcycle.

Emergency services attended and the motorcyclist, a 37-year-old man, was taken by ambulance to the Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh where they remain for treatment to serious injuries.

The occupants of the car were not injured.

The road was closed and reopened around 2.05am on Thursday, 19 September.

Sergeant Jen Niven said: "Our enquiries are ongoing to establish the full circumstances of what happened, and we are asking anyone who can assist to get in touch.

"If you were in the area at the time and can help or have dash-cam footage that has captured useful information then please make contact with officers."
