Cichy nets to lift Fife Flyers up Elite League table

Flyers edged ahead again 13 minutes after that with Martineau on the mark again but back came Storm after 35 minutes to level at 2-2.

Cichy's strike kept the points at Kirkcaldy and Fife travel to Nottingham Panthers on Sunday (16.00) also in the Elite League.

Elsewhere, Glasgow Clan beat Dundee Stars 5-2 at Braehead in the Challenge Cup in front of more than 2,800 fans and they were 4-0 ahead after the first two period but Stars hit back to win the third period 2-1.

On Sunday, Stars host Sheffield Steelers (17.00) in the league.
