Detectives launch investigation after woman attacked in Dalkeith

Detectives are appealing for information after a woman was seriously assaulted in Dalkeith.

Between 5.30pm and 6pm on Friday, 4 October, 2024, the 26-year-old was approached by a man who attacked her on a path in a wooded area near the golf club on Abbey Road.

Emergency services attended and the woman was taken to hospital with serious injuries.

Enquiries are ongoing to establish the full circumstances and officers are appealing for witnesses.

The man is described as white, in his late 30s with stubble. He was wearing black trousers, a black waterproof jacket and had a dog lead around his neck, but it is not believed he had a dog with him.

Detective Inspector Laura White said: "It's vital we trace the person responsible.

"If anyone was in the wooded area, or the golf club on Abbey Road, around the time and saw this man or anything which may assist our enquiries, I'd urge them to come forward. Similarly, if you recognise the description, please get in touch.

"I'd also like to ask anyone with private CCTV, doorbell or dashcam footage of this area to review it and bring anything

of significance to our attention.

"We are aware this incident has caused alarm in the local community however, I would like to reassure the public, everything possible is being done and there will continue to be an increased police presence in the area as our investigation progresses. Anyone with concerns can speak to these officers."
