"We're here to break that taboo. Pip Social is about normalising being single, and offering people the chance to get together with other single people who aren't just interested in dating, but in making real friendships and having a laugh."

Being single doesn't define you — it empowers you to define your own life. And when you get a bunch of strong, single people in a room together, magic happens. That's what Pip Social is all about."

Sarah said: "This isn't a stuffy event. If you've never done a ceilidh before, no problem! We'll teach you the moves — just bring your energy, your Christmas spirit, and your best dancing shoes. We wanted to create a space where being single is a cause for celebration, not shame.

"It's time to show the world that single doesn't mean lonely. It means independent, empowered, and fabulous!"
