Also, Young Ambassadors were credited with being integral to school sport and physical activity delivery. Consequently, there has been an 80% increase in extra-curricular participation across the last 18 months, reinforcing the impact the Young Ambassadors have had on school programmes.

Pupil voice is clearly a critical part of the approach and ethos of the school and this is evident throughout the Gold School Sport Award application.
