Players may also need to enter a promotional code, so be sure to check the instructions for redeeming your bonus. You wouldn't want to miss this exclusive chance because of the missing simple step!

It is a great mistake to try to cheat an online casino when it comes to bonuses. It is a must to complete the KYC verification and provide an ID, so a casino can easily recognize a player when he or she decides to withdraw winnings.

Using Free Spins On Games Where They Don't Work

Most players want to utilize bonus spins by playing games that bring about the highest winnings. Most players choose these games by RTP or the availability of a progressive jackpot, but there are players who may try to spend free spins not on the games listed in the bonus terms. Naturally, these games can be played only in a demo mode or for real money, while free spins will disappear only if you spend them on the games of choice or miss the expiration date.

Combining Different Casino Bonuses

Most online casinos permit you to have just one bonus active at any given moment. If you attempt to claim another bonus while one is still in play, you might be refused or experience that the new bonus replaces the first one. While this might not be a serious breach of the casino's rules, the operator could interpret it as an attempt to cheat the system and might even close your account. Always ensure you have only one bonus active at a time.

If you want to benefit from different bonuses simultaneously, the best way to do that is to claim them in different casinos.

Many people think that they must accept every casino bonus available there, but that's not the case! You have the freedom to be picky when it comes to the bonuses you choose. If wagering conditions seem too difficult to fulfill, you don't like the games, or you'd rather avoid depositing, it's perfectly okay to neglect the bonus offered.

Wagering Bonus Money By Playing Games That Don't Contribute To The Playthrough Requirements

All casinos outline the wagering contributions associated with every bonus in their full versions of terms and conditions. As it was pointed out earlier, it is crucial to read this information carefully and evaluate which games help meet these wagering requirements. Slots usually offer the highest contribution at 100%, while live casino and table games often have lower contributions due to their lower house edge. In some cases, these games can contribute as little as 10% or even 0%.

Be sure to use your bonus on games that help meet the wagering requirements, especially those with a higher contribution. If you accidentally play a game that contributes 0%, you will waste your time since you won't be able to withdraw your winnings!
