
## Whispers from the underground — Kyloe's speakeasy feast


## The Secret Knock

The transformation is magical. What was once a cocktail bar becomes an intimate dining space for the night, complete with waiters (big shout out to ours, Joshua, who played his part


with style and panache) who look like they've stepped straight out of a vintage film reel — crisp white coat-tails, pressed black trousers, the works.
