Raising awareness of the charity and community space and the events they run, Duncan Place will be onsite all day to provide a range of free activities for folks at Gala Day to take part in. 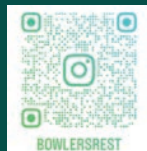

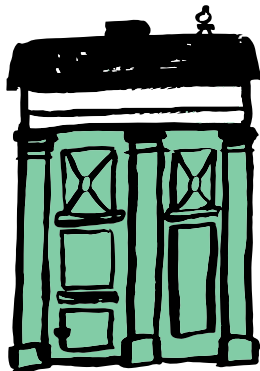
